

Is the Home Scoutmaster Involved? The conference is designed to strengthen the relationship between the youth leader and his UNIT LEADER. The Unit leader is strongly encouraged to attend an after conference session (date TBD) with the youth leader on how to best use the newly trained youth leader in the unit. At this session, the Scout and the adult leader will agree on the application of leadership skills learned at the conference that will benefit the Unit's program and help to develop the Scout's leadership skills.

Is any Special Equipment Needed? An equipment list will be sent to each participant after the reservation is received. Scouts who participate in an active Troop outdoor program probably already have the necessary personal equipment. A full **official uniform** is required. (The new uniform released in the summer of 2008 or any previous official B.S.A. uniform is acceptable.) Each participant should make sure that badges and insignia are properly placed and that the uniform is worn correctly.

What About Medical Forms? Scouts must use the BSA Annual Health and Medical Record number 34605 which is available on line. Also, all medical forms must have been completed after July 29, 2011.

What Does the Course Cost? The conference fee is \$200.00, which includes all food and training materials. **For reservations fully paid by March 30, there is a \$10.00 discount, or a total fee of \$190.00.** A deposit of \$50.00 per Scout should accompany each reservation. The balance must be paid by May 31. The fee does not cover personal uniform and equipment or transportation to and from camp.

Scouts who do not pre-register may not be able to attend the course. The course has room for only a limited number of participants. If you are thinking of sending Scouts to NYLT, please sign them up early to hold a place.

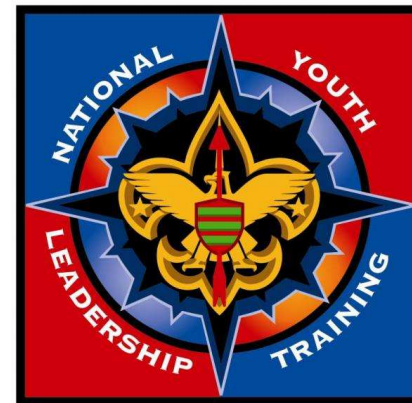

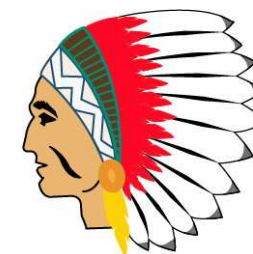

NATIONAL YOUTH LEADERSHIP TRAINING Course

Purpose: The training of youth leaders in the Unit is important in helping individual Scouts, Venturers, and the Unit grow. The Boy Scouts of America has developed a six-day training experience, the **National Youth Leadership Training Course** (NYLT) that has proven valuable in the training of youth leaders. The course will stress the skills of leadership that will make youth leaders more effective in their Unit leadership positions.

Perhaps more importantly, the Scout or Venturer will be exposed to living skills that will allow him to become a successful leader in any organization. This course will provide the youth with the tools that he needs to develop his leadership potential. The skills taught will immensely facilitate the Unit Leader's leadership development of the youth and directly benefit the Unit's program.

Qualifications: Any Scout who participates in the course must be at least a **First Class Scout and 13 years old (but not yet 18)**, and a Scout that **the Unit Leader** feels is mature and currently filling a Unit leadership position or likely to assume a leadership position in the near future. The Scout may **only** attend on the Unit Leader's recommendation. It is important that the Scout have camping, cooking and hiking skills. **There is no rank requirement for Venturers – but a recommendation is required.**

Location and Time: The course will be held on two weekends – July 20-22 and July 27-29, 2012 at Camp Tuscarora. The course will be led by Course Director Doug Lamb and an experienced staff of youth and adult trainers. The start time for each weekend is 1:00 pm. The course ends at 7:00 pm weekend one and 6:00 pm the second weekend.

Please discuss this training opportunity with your Patrol Leaders Council and Troop Committee as soon as possible.

More information about the conference is below. So that we can do advance planning, it is very important that all reservations are sent to the Tuscarora Council office with full payment by May 31, 2011.

NYLT FACTS

What is NYLT? The National Youth Leadership Training Course is a one week outdoor experience for youth leaders in support of the Unit Leader's responsibility for training the Unit's youth leaders. It is conducted by the Tuscarora Council's Training Committee using a syllabus published by the Boy Scouts of America.

NYLT replaces the Junior Leader Training Conference, which was last offered in 2004.

What is its Purpose? Scouting recognizes that Unit Leaders have the responsibility of training their own youth leaders. The purpose of the National Youth Leadership Training Course is not to assume the Unit Leader's role, but to support it. The course objectives are:

1. To enhance the relationship between the participant and his Unit Leaders.
2. To have fun.
3. To give participants a basic knowledge of the skills of leadership and help them relate these skills to their Troop or Crew responsibilities.
4. To give participants the opportunity to share ideas and experience with youth from other Units.
5. To give participants the confidence and knowledge to run the Unit program.
6. To create an atmosphere where Scouts and Venturers will experience Scouting at its best.
